ARA SUBMISSION ON DRAFT NSW PUBLIC HEALTH (TOBACCO) REGULATION 2022

The Australian Retailers Association (ARA) welcomes the opportunity to comment on comment on the Draft NSW Public Health (Tobacco) Regulation and accompanying Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS). We note that the draft Regulation will replace the existing instrument which is due to sunset on 1 September 2022.
