NSW: ANZAC Day (Sat 25 Apr 2026) is full-day closed for non-exempt shops; Mon 27 Apr is an additional public holiday, but ANZAC trading restrictions do not apply.

SA: Non-Proclaimed Shopping Districts (most regional SA) are deregulated; restrictions mainly apply to Metro/Gleneelg, CBD Tourist Precinct and Proclaimed districts.

ACT: In 2026, the ACT will observe both Saturday 25 April and Monday 27 April as public holidays; retail trading hours remain deregulated (no trading restrictions).
